ECLIPSE BASICS

Eclipses are part of the complex relationship between the Sun, Moon and Earth: they are extra potent New and Full Moons, which our school calls a Super New Moon or Super Full Moon.

Eclipses occur when the **Sun, Moon and Earth** align and one casts a shadow —either on the earth (solar eclipse) on a New Moon or the Earth's shadow is cast onto the Moon during a Full Moon. This kind of alignment is called a **Syzygy**.

More to Know about Eclipses

Each year has two **Eclipse Seasons** separated by about six months.

Each **Eclipse Season** has **at least two eclipses**; one **Solar Eclipse** and one **Lunar Eclipse**.

Sometimes an **Eclipse Year** can have **three Eclipses** in each season, totaling **6 Eclipses**. This is rare, and can only occur when a

- **Solar Eclipse** is surrounded by two minor Penumbral Lunar Eclipses, two weeks prior and two weeks after;
- Or a **Total Lunar Eclipse** is surrounded by two minor **Partial Solar Eclipses** two weeks before and after.

Three Eclipses in one season occurs about **eight times** every **28 years**.

Solar Eclipses occur with a **New Moon**. Think of it as a **Super New Moon** since it super amplifies the New Moon energy.

SOLAR AND LUNAR ECLIPSES

Solar Eclipses at the **North Node**

are a *seed point* and a place of **conscious intention**, a portal into possible futures—if and only if the shadow of the personal and collective past is addressed.

Solar Eclipses at the **South Node**

place a greater emphasis on the past shadow, a greater necessity to take the personal and collective past into account before the seed of intention for a future can be as powerful.

Lunar Eclipses occur with the **Full Moon**:

We think of them as Super Full Moons as the energy is amplified. Full Moons are more about awareness and potential illumination, and can be rather overwhelming. Shadows are brought to light.

Lunar North Node Eclipses emphasize the **Future**:

The North Node is more about the future directional flow of personal and collective humanity. It can include our soul's intention to reach its destination point, but only after first addressing the past.

Lunar South Node Eclipses relate to our **Collective Past**:

and where personal and collective humanity have previously been. These may be areas where we need to have conscious awareness of before we can go forward.

Personal and Collective Significance of Eclipses

Your Personal Chart: If the degrees of the eclipse are within 10 degrees on either side of your **Sun, Moon, Natal Chart Angles or Personal Planets**, you are on the front lines of the eclipse.

A **Saros** is a **Family of Eclipses** that occur every 18 years and 11 days, (223 Synodic Months, 6585.32 Days). This repeating pattern of Eclipse series occurs for 1226-1550 years and is comprised of 69 to 87 eclipses according to NASA.

The **Saros Cycle**, the **Nodal Cycle** of 18.6 years, and the **Metonic Cycle** of 19 years are the three most important cycles that involve the Moon. These rather complex cycles also include the Lunar Standstill Cycle.

*Then, at the time just past the exact point of the New Moon, **direct attention and focus intention on planting the seeds for the future.***








