



The Lunar Nodes

Lunar Nodes are the intersection points between the orbit of the Moon and the path of the Sun as seen from the Earth and are directly related to eclipses



Sun: source of light and Life for Planet Earth
Determines night and day.

Moon: determines the tides and affects the tectonic plates of the Earth and moods.

Nodes: are the points in space where the orbit of the Sun and Moon intersect on the ecliptic (plane of the solar system creating the eclipse experienc.

The Exact Nodal Cycles occur at Ages: 18.6, 37.2, 55.8, and 74.4.....


As taught in our Shamanic Timeline,

North Node on a Personal Axis

This is at the **highest level of being in alignment** with your **Soul's Intention**— when the **future Self** is reaching back to get **your attention**

This is time to **work ceremonially** with the **Nodal transit**.

The transit window is three months prior and three months following the target degree (6 mos.)

The North Node is an **Activation of that planet or point**, aligning it the **Future Destination of the Soul**.

LUNAR NODES IN SCORPIO/TAURUS

Sometimes coincides with Natural Disaster and Severe Weather

January 15, 2022, an underwater volcano erupted off the island of Tonga blasting rocks, ash and steam an incredible 60,000ft, into the sky

This will have a cooling climate effect for at least the next couple of months and depending on the duration and size of the eruption could cool the planet...

The shock wave from the eruption is expected to reverberate around the world.

The strength of the massive eruption was **VEI 5**.

The famous Krakatau eruption **Aug 26, 1883**, was a **VEI 6**.

VEI) The Volcanic Explosivity Index is a scale that describes the size of explosive volcanic eruptions based on magnitude and intensity

The numerical scale (from 0 to 8) is a logarithmic scale.

It is analogous to the Richter and other magnitude scales for the size of earthquakes.

According to Wikipedia, **the Krakatau Eruption caused a volcanic winter.**

In the year following the eruption, average Northern Hemisphere summer temperatures fell by .72 °F.

The record rainfall that hit Southern California during the water year from July 1883 to June 1884 – Los Angeles received 38.18 in.

and San Diego 25.97 in – has been attributed to the Krakatoa eruption.

This eruption could be the perfect geological event to cool the planet.

The North Node was in Scorpio and the South node in Taurus
